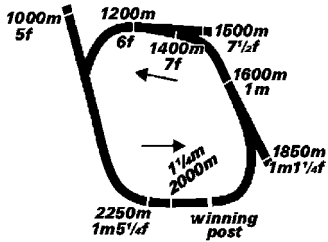


Metropolitan and Country Track Maps and

CHELTENHAM PARK

Track: Grass Circumference: 2052m
Length of Straight: 393m



- 6 km North West of Adelaide.
- Access is via Cheltenham Parade or Torrens Road, level surface of mostly 22 metres width.
- Excellent wet weather racing surface and track is well grassed.
- Type of soil is a sandy loam and the track is fully irrigated.

CEDUNA

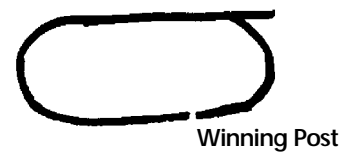
Track: Dirt Circumference: 2000m
Length of Straight: 425m



- Features dirt based oiled track
- The Racecourse also features 1000, 1600 and 1800 metre specialised starting chutes, with races also able to start from the 1200 and 1400 metre marks.

JAMESTOWN

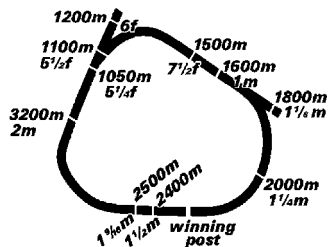
Track: Dirt Circumference: 1600m
Length of Straight: 400m



- The course itself is situated about 2.5km south of Jamestown on the Jamestown-Spalding Road.
- The track is flat (having no undulations). The Club is able to program the following races: 1000m, 1200m, 1340m and 1700m (1340m events are started from a chute forming an extension to the back-straight – offering about a 600m run to the turn)

Allan Scott Park MORPHETTVILLE

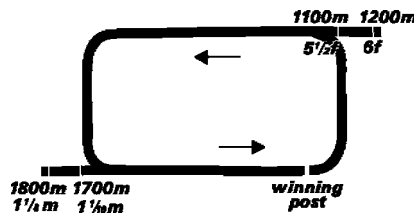
Track: Grass Circumference: 2327m
Length of Straight: 330m



- 7 kms west of Adelaide, access via ANZAC Highway.
- Track is 30 metres wide, well grassed with sweeping cambered turns, well drained racing surface.
- Type of soil is sandy and the track is fully irrigated.

CLARE

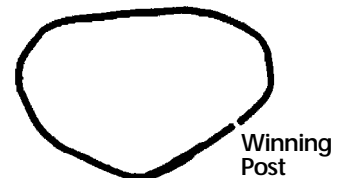
Track: Grass Circumference: 1450m
Length of Straight: 220m



- Clare Valley Racing Club is located in the heart of the picturesque Clare Valley, 3 km's north of Clare.
- A 1450m track with chutes for 1200m & 1800m nestled in a valley surrounded by rolling hills and grapevines, it is an irrigated grassed track consisting of a mix of clay soils.

KANGAROO ISLAND

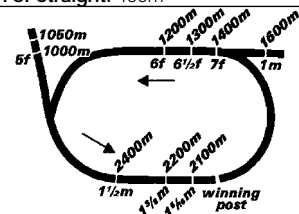
Track: Grass Circumference: 1600m
Length of Straight: 375m



- The Kangaroo Island Racing Club is situated 8 kms from Kingscote, running 3 meetings per year.
- Offers a spacious circuit with oval track and long straights and two broad turns, the track is fully irrigated, well grassed and quite uniform.
- The soil type is sand over clay.

BALAKLAVA

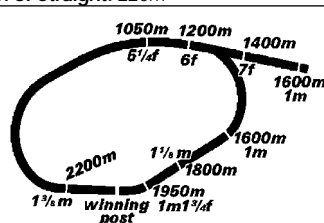
Track: Grass Circumference: 2053m
Length of Straight: 450m



- The Balaklava race course situated 100 kms north of Adelaide on the flat Adelaide Plains in the heart of the SA cereal belt.
- The track layout is a large flat ellipse, is 23 m wide with a sweeping home turn.
- The track surface is Kikuyu grass over clay subsoil.
- It has two shutes for the 1050m start and the 1600m start and other starts at 1200, 1300, 1400 and 2200m.

GAWLER

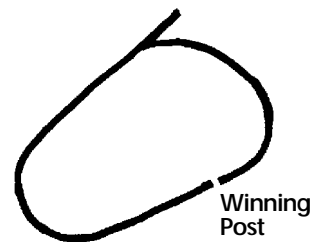
Track: Grass Circumference: 2030m
Length of Straight: 220m



- The Gawler Racecourse is situated 35Kms. North West of the central business district of Adelaide.
- The track itself is self sufficient in water.
- The grasses used on the track are predominantly Kikuyu with perennial and annual rye grasses in the mix and grown on a sandy loam profile which provides a great racing surface.

LOCK

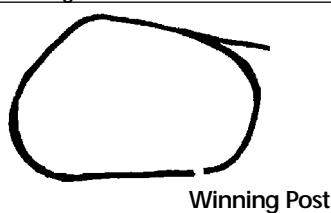
Track: Dirt Circumference: 1450m

- The Lock racing club holds one annual meeting near the start of every year.
- The track can cater for races up to 2000 metres with 2000, 1900, 1800 metre starts.

BORDERTOWN

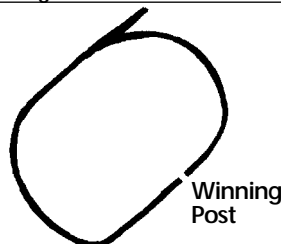
Track: Grass Circumference: 1606m
Length of Straight: 310m



- The racing surface is a flat irrigated grass surface .
- The racing width varies from 15 - 18m.
- 4 basic starting positions - 1100m 1200m 1300m (chute) and 1900m. Able to start 12 horses from each position.

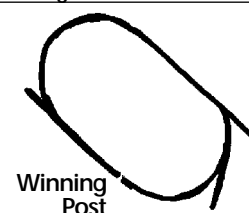

MINDARIE - HALIDON

Track: Grass Circumference: 1600m
Length of Straight: 300m



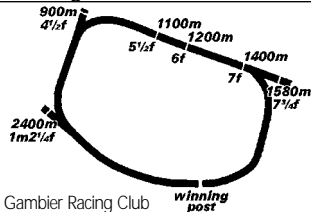
- The Mindarie-Halidon races are held once a year at the end of September.
- The races are situated approximately 200km from Adelaide on the Murray Bridge - Karoonda - Loxton Road.
- The track is grassed with a rye grass clover mix, with a sandy loam soil.
- Races vary in length from 1000 to 1800 metres.

Descriptions

MOUNT GAMBIER

Track: Grass Circumference: 1850m

Length of Straight: 400m

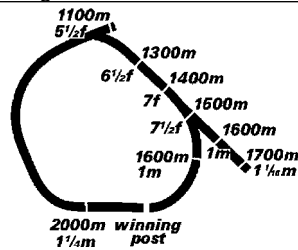


- Mount Gambier Racing Club has been racing at Glenburnie Racecourse since 1883 which is situated approximately 7 kilometres from the city centre.
- Consisting of three tracks – the course proper (1850m), steeple course (1600m) and sand track – and starting chutes at the 900m, 1550m, 1800m and 2400m (Gold Cup start).
- The most distinguishing feature of the Glenburnie track is the Dog Leg at the 200m in the home straight.

PENOLA

Track: Grass Circumference: 1835m

Length of Straight: 280m

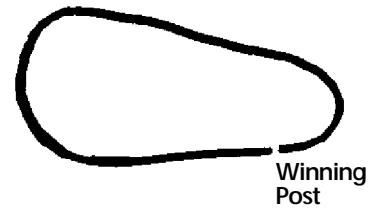


- The Penola Racing Club is set in the picturesque surroundings of the vineyards of the Coonawarra region of South East South Australia.
- The Penola Racing Club is home of the Penola Cup, Coonawarra Cup and Vinerons Cup.

Track: Dirt Circumference: 1700m

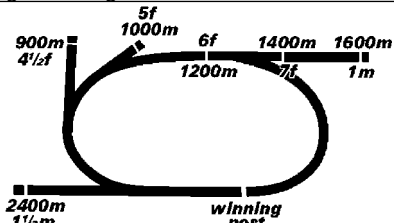

MURRAY BRIDGE

Track: Grass Circumference: 1884m

Length of Straight: 420m



- A wide spacious course, features a slight incline from 1500m to 1000m, decline from 900m to the point of the home straight.
- The track is grassed with Dominant Kikuyu grass track with Rye grass.
- The course is 20 metres wide.

PENONG

Track: Dirt Circumference: 2000m

Length of Straight: 500m

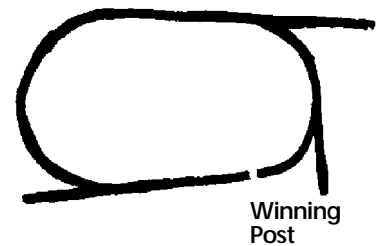

- Penong is the last town in SA before heading across the Nullabor. The race course is 2 km west of the town on the Eyre Highway, on very flat land, so horses are in full view throughout their race.
- As the flats surrounding Penong (the town of windmills) are the catchment for the area's groundwater supply, the last thing the Penong Racing Club needs is a 200ml downpour just before the races!

ROXBY DOWNS

Track: Dirt/Sand Circumference: 1400m

Length of Straight: 260m

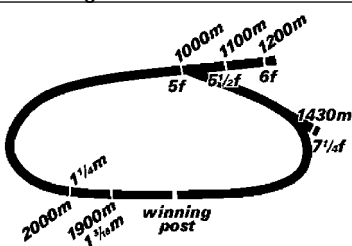


- Roxby Downs Racing Club is the most northern racing club in SA.
- Field limit 12 is all races
- The club conducts one non tab meeting per year.

NARACOORTE

Track: Grass Circumference: 1730m

Length of Straight: 270m

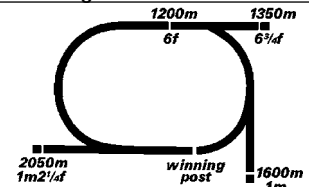


- Port August is less than 300km, North of Adelaide on National Highway 1.
- It is the only track in SA racing that holds the states registered TAB circuit on dirt.
- The cambered sand track is constructed of a tri-sand mix designed to give consistent cushioning for the thoroughbred horse in a minimal rainfall area.

STRATHALBYN

Track: Grass Circumference: 1690m

Length of Straight: 340m

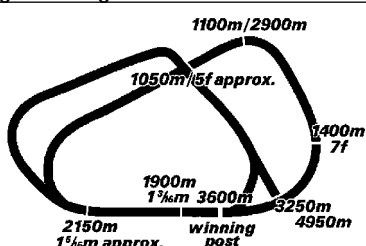


- Situated just 50 minutes from the heart of Adelaide via the South Eastern Freeway.
- The track fully irrigated and well grassed with some undulations.
- Track is renowned for the hill on the turn into the home straight.
- A fully automated irrigation system has been installed, with water secured through a joint deal with Alexandrina Council, allowing for significantly improved maintenance of the track and surroundings.

OAKBANK

Track: Grass Circumference: 1797m

Length of Straight: 360m

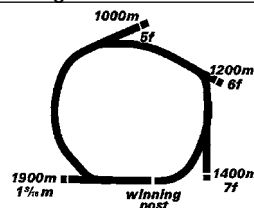


- The racecourse is located in the Adelaide Hills approximately 40km east of the Adelaide CBD.
- It has an undulating racing surface consisting of 2 separate tracks (flat and steeple) both of approximately 1800m in length with an average width of 18m.

PORT LINCOLN

Track: Grass Circumference: 1600m

Length of Straight: 300m



- Grass is a mix of Kikuyu, Rye and clover. Soil type is sandy loam over limestone. Track has small undulating areas.
- 1000M, 1350M & 1950M shoots are part of the track layout.
- PLRC conducts 15 TAB race meetings from early October thru to April.
- Port Lincoln Racing Club also stages the Kimba Cup conducted annually in late March.

STREAKY BAY

Track: Dirt Circumference: 1600m

Length of Straight: 320m

- 1400 metres chute.
- Annual meeting-late March or early April.
- Track is on Flinders Highway, 5 kilometres east of Streaky Bay towards Ceduna/Poochera.
- Streaky Bay is 720 kilometres west of Adelaide on the west coast of Eyre Peninsula.
