



THOROUGHBRED RACING SA LIMITED
STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

ALLAN SCOTT PARK MORPHETTVILLE – THURSDAY, 8 MAY 2008

Stewards have inquired into the substance *oxazepam* being detected in a urine sample provided by licensed jockey, Chris Bryant at Oakbank on Monday, 24 March 2008.

Evidence was taken from Chris Bryant and a report tendered by a medical expert was considered. In addition, Stewards considered a report by, and took evidence from, Dr J Vine, Director, Racing Analytical Services Limited in relation to this sample.

After considering the evidence taken, Chris Bryant was found guilty of an offence under ARR.81A(1) in that the sample provided contained *oxazepam*, a substance banned under ARR.81B. He was suspended from riding in races for a period of eight (8) weeks of which four (4) weeks was suspended provided he is not found guilty of a breach of ARR.81A & ARR.81B in the next twelve months. The remaining four week suspension period, having taken account of the period of nine days Chris Bryant had been stood down for following notification of the irregularity, is effective from midnight 12 May and to conclude at midnight on 31 May 2008.
