### **STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORT**

#### **ADDITIONAL REPORT – MONTEGO BAY**

##### **ALLAN SCOTT PARK MORPHETTVILLE – FRIDAY, 30 MAY 2008**

Stewards have inquired into several matters concerning the lease of the racehorse MONTEGO BAY.

The Stewards confirmed the Lessees remained in dispute. The Lessees were again referred to Clause 3(g) of the Lease of Racehorse Agreement and encouraged to seek a resolution through arbitration.

The Stewards also confirmed that pending resolution of the matters in dispute, the nomination of MONTEGO BAY to race would not be accepted.

Mr. A.G. Rohloff, a Lessee who holds an Owner Trainer's Permit, was questioned regarding training fees charged for this horse and the racehorse SHORTBRED. After considering the evidence, the Stewards determined not to charge Mr. Rohloff with a breach of the Rules but informed him his Permit allowed him to recover costs but he was not permitted to charge fees for training.

Mr. A.G. Rohloff, being the Trainer of MONTEGO BAY, and Mr. M. Conroy, the managing Lessee, were questioned regarding the whereabouts of MONTEGO BAY from the evening of Saturday, 22 March 2008, following its racing at Clare, and Sunday, 6 April 2008, when the gelding raced at Mount Gambier. It was determined that from Monday, 24 March 2008 until Saturday, 29 March 2008 MONTEGO BAY was located on a Myponga property in the control of Mr. Conroy. Although the Stewards were satisfied that for the period MONTEGO BAY was not in the care of a licensed trainer and was in breach of Local Rule 11.5, having considered all relevant matters, they determined to take no action.

With regard to a complaint laid against a previous trainer of MONTEGO BAY, Stewards advised Mr. Conroy that as they could establish no substance to his belief, they did not intend to progress an investigation further.
