

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED
STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Cheltenham Park Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 5 April 2008

Stewards: P. Anderson (A/Chairman), M Santoro (HT), T Williamson (F) & D Southgate (M) (Stewards), L Smith, D Jonas, M Smith & J Shea (Deputy Stewards) & Dr. P Horridge (Veterinary Surgeon).

TRACK: Dead 4

WEATHER: Fine

Rail: Out 3 metres from the 1450 metres to the Winning Post

RACE 1 : GERALD QUIGLEY MEMORIAL HANDICAP - 1000 metres

MISSY GIGGLE (J Maund) and KAYEEMA JAY (D Tootell) jumped away awkwardly and bumped.

Racing to the 900 metres SHARE MY DAY (A Patterson) had to steady to avoid the heels of KAYEEMA JAY (D Tootell).

On entering the straight KAYEEMA JAY (D Tootell) rolled away from MISSY GIGGLE (J Maund) and brushed SHARE MY DAY (A Patterson), which shifted out and inconvenienced WHITE COUNTESS (P Gatt).

Approaching the 300 metres MR LANGER (W Hughes) shifted out to gain clear running and brushed MISSY GIGGLE (J Maund).

T Zanker, the rider of CAVALRY BLACK, explained to the Stewards that the gelding had begun well but in the early stages of the race had a tendency to change stride and race greenly and as a result, lost contact with the field. T Zanker added that CAVALRY BLACK only really stretched out from the 200 metres and finished the race off well. CAVALRY BLACK was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

KAYEEMA JAY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.

RACE 2 : PATRICKS/DUNES HANDICAP - 1000 metres

Acting on confirmed telephone advice from Trainer Mr. L Macdonald, that VICTORY CHANT had a foot abscess and was unfit to race, Stewards ordered the withdrawal of VICTORY CHANT at 9.20 am.

Acting on a confirmed telephone call from Trainer Mr. J Stephens that BLUEPOLES had injured its head when being loaded into the float and was unfit to race, Stewards withdrew that gelding at 10.30 am.

COURT BELL (T Baker) knuckled severely on jumping away.

Racing to the 700 metres INDOVINA (P Gatt) eased the pace, which resulted in KISS THE CASH (D Tourneur) having to be steadied and as a result got its head up and shifted out, inconveniencing SHEEZA PERIL (A Hermann).

RACE 2 : PATRICKS/DUNES HANDICAP - 1000 metres (Cont'd)

Approaching the 100 metres COURT BELL (T Baker) laid in under pressure and bumped PRIVATE LIAISON (M Neilson).

D Tourneur, the rider of KISS THE CASH, explained his instructions were to ride the filly quietly and that after the incident, when racing to the 800 metres, he was unable to gain clear running and on entering the straight, was unable to gain a clear run between INDOVINA (P Gatt) and PRIVATE LIAISON (M Neilson) due to insufficient room. D Tourneur stated when approaching the 200 metres he looked for a run to the inside of INDOVINA and was again disappointed and he then shifted out to gain clear ground but was unable to do so to the finish.

M Neilson, the rider of PRIVATE LIAISON, reported he had his whip struck from his hand in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

COURT BELL was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the filly to be lame in the off foreleg and had sustained a laceration during the event. First Aid was administered. Ms. P. Trenwith, the Trainer of COURT BELL, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

PRIVATE LIAISON was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the colt had sustained a laceration to the offside hock during the even. First Aid was administered.

RACE 3 : DISTINCTIVE HOMES HANDICAP - 1810 metres

After entering the straight FANTHEN (D Robinson) was unable to gain clear running until about the 150 metres.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres MAN OF CLASS (T Baker) laid in and made contact with FANTHEN (D Robinson), which rolled out.

Approaching the 100 metres MISS DAEA (K Stra) laid in and shifted ground forcing K Stra to stop riding and straighten her mount.

Correct Weight was delayed to permit T Baker, the rider of MAN OF CLASS, to view the official footage in the straight.

RACE 4 : CHALLENGE SERIES 2008 FINAL - 1310 metres

SPECIAL BLONDE (P Gatt) was slow to begin.

MOLOKAI'S LADD (W Hughes) reared when the gates opened.

BIRUBU WESTERN (P Roff) and ECHO BOUND (J Lyon) jumped away awkwardly.

Racing to the 1000 metres BIRUBU WESTERN (P Roff) commenced to over-race and had to be steadied to avoid the heels of THEWHOLESHEBANG (T Baker). BIRUBU WESTERN then got its head up and raced ungenerously for some distance.

Approaching the 900 metres MOLOKAI'S LADD (W Hughes) over-raced.

RACE 5 : QUEEN'S CUP - 2414 metres

PRINCIPAL DAME (J Lyon) and FRAACLASE (K Post) bumped on jumping away.

Racing between the 1600 and 1200 metres FRENZILIAN (A Hermann), which was over-racing, had to steady off the heels of PRINCIPAL DAME (J Lyon) on several occasions.

D Tootell, the rider of FOOLISH LAD, explained that racing to the 500 metres he had to restrain the gelding off the heels of SPARKLING TOP (D Tourneur) and was further held up for clear running until gaining a run to the outside of FRENZILIAN (A Hermann) at the 300 metres.

Approaching the 200 metres SILENT ACTION (C Bryant) had to be steadied off the heels of TAYLLAROO (P Gatt) when that gelding rolled out.

Over the final 100 metres TAYLLAROO (P Gatt) laid out brushing PRINCIPAL DAME (J Lyon), which had a tendency to lay in, on several occasions.

Correct Weight was delayed to permit J Lyon, the rider of the second placegetter PRINCIPAL DAME, that mare's Trainer Ms. K. Huxtable, together with D Yendall, the rider of third placegetter STREETFIGHTER, and Mr. S. Mathrick, representing Trainer Mr. T. Mathrick, to view the official footage in the straight.

RACE 6 : H C NITSCHKE STAKES - 1460 metres

GRAVITRON (W Hughes) was slow to start.

On jumping away ESPRIT DE DANSE (D Yendall) brushed DANEDINA (D Tourneur).

Shortly after the start DANROSSA (M Neilson) shifted in taking CATALAN BAY (T Baker) in, resulting in DANEDINA (D Tourneur) being hampered.

Approaching the 1300 metres DANEROSSA (M Neilson) had to be steadied to avoid the heels of DANEDINA (D Tourneur) owing to that filly shifting ground.

In the vicinity of the 1200 metres LA VISCOMTESSA (R Plumb) got its head up and raced ungenerously for some distance.

In the vicinity of the 500 metres CATALAN BAY (T Baker) had to be checked to avoid the heels of MOONSONG (C Lindop) and was unable to gain clear running until approximately the 300 metres.

Approaching the 200 metres DANROSSA (M Neilson) had to be steadied to avoid the heels of THESANDMANCAN (P Gatt), which rolled out.

Racing to the 100 metres DANROSSA (M Neilson) had to check due to DANEDINA (D Tourneur) shifting in at the same time as THESANDMANCAN (P Gatt) shifted out. D Tourneur and P Gatt were advised of their obligations when shifting ground.

MOONSONG lost its near hind plate during the event.

DANROSSA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.

RACE 6 : H C NITSCHKE STAKES - 1460 metres (Cont'd)

GRAVITRON was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.

ESPRIT DE DANSE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : ALLAN SCOTT PARK MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1410 metres

SARABEE (D Tourneur) was slow to begin.

VIZ VITAE (NZ) (R Plumb) jumped away awkwardly.

On jumping away SECRET DAUGHTER (A Hermann) was hampered by SAVLATE (NZ) (C Bryant), which shifted out, and MISS RAZZLE DAZZLE (J Lyon), which shifted in.

Racing to the 1000 metres SARABEE (D Tourneur) had to be checked to avoid the heels of VIZ VITAE (NZ) (R Plumb).

Approaching the 1100 metres CAMPASPE RIVER (A Patterson) had to be steadied to avoid the heels of HEAVENS JESTER (C Lindop).

ETON was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8 : TORO HANDICAP - 1000 metres

IL DUCA (D Tootell) was slow to begin.

Racing inside the 200 metres OUR DIOR (C Lindop) shifted out resulting in SURELY YOU JEST (W Kerford) having to be steadied and change course inwards to obtain a clear run. C Lindop was advised of her obligations when shifting ground.
