

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED
STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Cheltenham Park Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 26 April 2008

Stewards: G. Loch (Chairman), P. Anderson (M) & T. Williamson (HT) (Stewards). C. Deakin (F), M. White, Z. Hamilton & H. Milne (Deputy Stewards), Dr. P. Horridge and Dr. D Bowden (Veterinary Surgeons).

TRACK: Dead 4 (*Reclassified from Good 3 at 11.15 am*) **WEATHER:** Overcast

Rail: True

RACE 1 : CLEANEVENT HURDLE - 3000 metres

WINDSWEPT ROAD (J Foster) was slow to jump.

NIP THE TIP was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a slightly elevated heart rate and a slow recovery.

RACE 2 : SCHWEPPE'S HANDICAP - 1000 metres

On jumping away EL SEIGNEUR (A Herrmann) rolled out and brushed NEW TRADITION (NZ) (D Yendall), which was inconvenienced.

Inside the 800 metres ZAAZORRO (D Dunn) shifted out across the heels of EL SEIGNEUR (A Herrmann) and inconvenienced OUR CURRENCY (D Tourneur).

For a short distance after entering the straight, when racing between the heels of EL SEIGNEUR (A Herrmann) and ZAAZORRO (D Dunn), NEW TRADITION (NZ) (D Yendall) was unable to gain clear ground.

RACE 3 : TOOHEYS NEW HANDICAP - 1000 metres

As the Stewards were able to confirm the identity of BLOW ME AWAY, for which the Identity Card was unavailable, the gelding was permitted to start. Mr P Blanch, the Trainer of BLOW ME AWAY, was reprimanded and advised that the Identity Card was required to be with the horse at all times.

FILOU SHOT (D Yendall) jumped away very awkwardly.

On jumping away STARTED WITHA KISS (A Herrmann) shifted out onto MAGICAL DANE (D Tootell), which was inconvenienced.

Inside the 700 metres LICENCED TO CHILL (D Dunn) rolled in marginally onto KENNY KID (T Baker), which was inconvenienced and obliged to race in restricted room for some distance between the heels of LICENCED TO CHILL and LOVES TOBOUGGY (B Claridge).

Near the 400 metres, in attempting to improve, KENNY KID (T Baker) rolled out marginally and brushed LICENCED TO CHILL (D Dunn).

LICENCED TO CHILL, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.

RACE 4 : WALTER BROWN STAKES - 1250 metres

On jumping away ALADAH (W Hughes) shifted in and contacted MANGANESE (D Tourneur), which had begun awkwardly.

MONTELIMAR (T Baker) was inclined to rear on jumping away.

Inside the 900 metres, when being restrained off the heels of TURQUIA (C Lindop), EXALTED KEETAH (A Patterson) got its head up and raced ungenerously for a short distance.

From the 500 metres LILIAN EVELYN (D Dunn) was inclined to lay out.

Near the 200 metres TAAMEER (NZ) (S Price) shifted in onto LILIAN EVELYN (D Dunn), which continued to lay out marginally, resulting in LILIAN EVELYN being obliged to steady off the heels of TAAMEER (NZ). S Price was reprimanded and advised in future he would be required to stop riding and straighten his mounts in similar circumstances.

Correct Weight was delayed to permit C Lindop, the rider of TURQUIA, to view the official footage from the 200 metres.

ALADAH, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

LILIAN EVELYN, which was inclined to lay out, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.

TURQUIA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the filly had sustained a minor laceration to its off hind cannon during the event.

RACE 5 : ALLAN SCOTT PARK MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1350 metres

OUR JESSIE BELLE (T Baker) was inclined to get its head up when jumping away.

Shortly after the start BABIJCZUK (NZ) (I Gundogdu) shifted in onto MISS RAZZLE DAZZLE (J Lyon) taking that mare in onto LAST WORD (J Maund), which was taken in onto BRILLIANT LIES (K Stra), which was forced to steady and lose its position.

In the vicinity of the 900 metres DOUBLE COVER (P Roff) was inclined to race keenly when being restrained.

RACE 6 : JOHN D LEE STAKES - 1400 metres

Near the 300 metres, in an attempt to improve, MANHATTAN SKY (J Maund) rolled out onto FLYING OBJECT (D Yendall), which was inconvenienced.

At the entrance to the straight IDALOU (D Dunn) had difficulty gaining clear ground when racing inside the heels of PEACEMAKER (C Lindop).

Inside the 300 metres IDALOU (D Dunn), in attempting to improve, shifted out onto and brushed AMYJAYE POWER (M Neilson), which was inconvenienced

Near the 100 metres PEACEMAKER (C Lindop) shifted out onto STILLME (D Tourneur), which was inconvenienced.

RACE 6 : JOHN D LEE STAKES - 1400 metres (continued)

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to permit D Tourneur, the rider of the second placegetter STILLME, and Mr P Jolly representing Trainer Mr D Jolly, to view the official footage from the 200 metres. After doing so, D Tourneur lodged an objection against PEACEMAKER (C Lindop) being declared the winner on the grounds of alleged interference from inside the 200 metres to the winning post. After taking evidence from all parties, on viewing the official footage and acting on their own observations, Stewards considered that although PEACEMAKER had shifted ground on two occasions the consequences were not sufficient to warrant interfering with the placings and *dismissed* D Tourneur's objection.

RACE 7 : LAELIA STAKES - 1450 metres

Near the 500 metres MOONSONG (J Maund) rolled in onto OUR PARFUMEE (T Baker), which was inconvenienced.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres BELTIJA (M Hoppo) became held up when racing behind CASCADE NOW (D. Tourneur).

Inside the 200 metres ZODIAC QUEEN (M Neilson) shifted out onto AMARIE (J Lyon) tightening that mare onto MOONSONG (J Maund), resulting in AMARIE being checked, losing its position and MOONSONG being hampered. M Neilson was found guilty of a breach of ARR.137(a) and suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Wednesday, 30 April and to conclude at midnight on Wednesday, 7 May 2008; a period of four (4) meetings.

D Dunn, the rider of BOLD MOMENT, reported the filly hung out throughout the event. BOLD MOMENT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities other than a slower than expected recovery.

M Neilson, the rider of ZODIAC QUEEN, reported the filly was inclined to lay out during the event. ZODIAC QUEEN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8 : RENNIKS EVENTS HANDICAP - 1250 metres

MISS PRESLEY (C Lever) was inclined to rear on jumping away.

On jumping away ECHO BOUND (A Herrmann) shifted in onto NOT AT ALLORDINARY (M Neilson) taking that mare in onto ALPINE STORM (M Hoppo) at the same time as ALPINE STORM received pressure from MISS PRESLEY (C Lever) on its inside, resulting in NOT AT ALLORDINARY being hampered.

D Dunn, the rider of RUINED CASTLE which performed below expectations, explained the horse had travelled well until the entrance to the straight but failed to respond to his riding thereafter and could offer no explanation for its performance. RUINED CASTLE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the horse to be lame in the off foreleg. Mr S Padman, the Trainer of RUINED CASTLE, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to RUINED CASTLE being presented for a future trial or race.
