**Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse**  
**by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Wednesday, 11 June 2008**

**RACE 1 : PARALOWIE MEATS / SABIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 1950 metres**

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to the late arrival of the ambulance on course.

ROBBIE'S WAY (NZ) (B. Petherick) lost its position shortly after the start when tightened between SON OF DE LAGO (M. Morita) and EL SHAHAR (D. Dunn), which both shifted ground slightly.

PLAY HIGH (M. Vassallo) raced keenly inside the 1600 metres for a short distance.

SOUTHERN FORTUNE (D. Tourneur) laid in, in the straight, and shifted in, resulting in ANDY'S ANGEL (M. Neilson) having to be momentarily steadied near the 100 metres.

ROBBIE'S WAY (NZ) (B. Petherick) was eased out of the event near the 500 metres. B. Petherick explained the gelding did not respond to his riding, commenced to give ground and had a tendency to lay in towards the inside running rail. He added that the gelding became unbalanced shortly after passing the 1600 metres. ROBBIE'S WAY (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 2 : SALISBURY NORTH FOOTBALL CLUB / SABIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 metres**

BARTER TIME (M. Hoppo) jumped away awkwardly.

BRISTOL BAY (J. Lyon) shifted out on jumping away and brushed with APACHEE DANCE (NZ) (D. Tourneur).

SUGAR AND SPITE (D. Tootell), which was under pressure near the 600 metres, commenced to give ground and was eased out of the event by its rider on entering the straight. D. Tootell explained the filly failed to respond to his riding and performed poorly. D. Tootell was spoken to in relation to his use of the whip on entering the straight when he struck the filly on one occasion behind the saddle when it was clearly out of contention and not responding to his riding. SUGAR AND SPITE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the filly to be suffering atrial fibrillation. Mr. M. Seyers, the Trainer of SUGAR AND SPITE, was advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

**RACE 3 : WILLASTON HOTEL / SABIS MAIDEN PLATE (Division 1) - 1050 metres**

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to a number of horses proving difficult to load.

DINGANE (P. Gatt) jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

DIESELINE (W. Hughes) got its head up shortly after the start and raced ungenerously for a short distance.

In the vicinity of the 500 metres DINGANE (P. Gatt), which was racing greenly, shifted out abruptly taking SPRING MIST (J. Lyon) wider, inconveniencing that mare.

Inside the 400 metres OUR OLIVIA (M. Neilson), which became held up for a number of strides when racing behind SARGEANT GARCIA (A. Herrmann), shifted out and brushed with AL LAZARO (T. Baker). Shortly thereafter OUR OLIVIA again shifted out making contact with AL LAZARO, taking that gelding out onto DINGANE (P. Gatt), resulting in contact between these two horses.

Shortly prior to entering the straight MISS SPECIALITY (M. Morita) improved onto the heels of THREE PAIR (K. Stra) and became momentarily held up. Thereafter, racing to the 100 metres MISS SPECIALITY, when improving to the outside of AL LAZARO (T. Baker), commenced to lay in and became awkward for a short distance.

DIESELINE, which raced greenly and was inclined to lay in, in the straight, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 4 : WILLASTON HOTEL / SABIS MAIDEN PLATE (Division 2) - 1050 metres**

There was a slight delay to the start of this event owing to a number of horses proving difficult to load.

Inside the 700 metres TINNY LIZZY (C. Lindop) was obliged to steady off the heels of PLATE MONEY (D. Dunn), which rolled out slightly.

Near the 600 metres MAID OF SHALFORD (A. Herrmann), which had improved of its own accord into a tight run between CENTRAL MARKET (M. Neilson) to its inside and AKHASICA (A. Patterson) to its outside, which had initially rolled out and thereafter rolled back in, became tightened, clipped the heels of AKHASICA, blundered and lost its position.

Inside the 400 metres CRAMMOND (J. Potter) became held up when racing behind TINNY LIZZY (C. Lindop), which had commenced to give ground. As a result CRAMMOND was held up until near the 300 metres where it was obliged to alter course to avoid the heels of TINNY LIZZY.

TINNY LIZZY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.

**RACE 5 : HAPPY BIRTHDAY PAM NUNN RATING 0-75 HANDICAP - 1950 metres**

In the vicinity of the 700 metres D. Tourneur, the rider of FLYING TRAPEZE, which raced keenly in the early and middle stages, accidentally dropped his whip. D. Tourneur was reprimanded and advised that similar instances of carelessness in the future may result in a penalty being imposed.

Near the 300 metres WILLIN (NZ) (C. Lindop) became held up for clear running when racing behind SILENT MANNERS (B. Petherick) for a short distance. As a consequence PERILLO (A. Patterson), which was following, also became held up for a short distance.

**RACE 5 : HAPPY BIRTHDAY PAM NUNN RATING 0-75 HANDICAP - 1950 metres (Cont'd)**

At the entrance to the straight REAL HARMONY (M. Hoppo) became held up for a number of strides when racing behind SANDSATIONAL (S. Bailey). REAL HARMONY was obliged to alter course to the outside of SANDSATIONAL to obtain clear running.

FLYING TRAPEZE (D. Tourneur) laid in severely in the straight placing its rider at a disadvantage. FLYING TRAPEZE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding had a laceration to the inside of the near side cheek.

**RACE 6 : ADELAIDE GALVANISING RATING 0-75 HANDICAP - 1600 metres**

ACACIA QUEEN (M. Hoppo) was slow to begin.

REDBACK TALAQ (T. Baker) and SOVEREIGN CONQUEST (S. Price) reared on jumping away.

DOUBLE COVER (L. Hopwood) laid in throughout in the straight. DOUBLE COVER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported minor cuts to the cheeks due to sharp teeth. Mr. D. Courtney, the Trainer of DOUBLE COVER, was advised the gelding's teeth needed attention.

In the vicinity of the 100 metres MR CHAT (D. Tourneur) raced in restricted room for a number of strides between RUINED CASTLE (D. Dunn), which rolled in, and DOUBLE RIPPLE (A. Herrmann), which rolled out.

REDBACK TALAQ, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 7 : WATERSEARCH RATING 0-75 HANDICAP - 1050 metres**

TATSUHARA (M. Neilson) and SHANGHAI LIL (A. Herrmann) were slow to begin.

Rounding the home turn LOVARAJA (K. Stra) was obliged to steady off the heels of AMENGEE (B. Petherick) and lost its position when AMENGEE rolled in slightly. B. Petherick was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

LOVARAJA lost its near hind plate during the event.

**RACE 8 : GAWLER SOUTH BAKERY RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1400 metres**

GOLDEN HAND (J. Maund) jumped away awkwardly.

NAPOLI BOY (M. Morita) laid in throughout the event placing its rider at a disadvantage.

GOLDEN HAND (J. Maund) commenced to give ground inside the 700 metres and was eased out of the event by its rider after entering the straight.

**RACE 9 : PETER KITTLE TOYOTA RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

ERNIE'S MOLLY (NZ) (L. Stojakovic) jumped away awkwardly.

MASTER MOOD (T. Zanker) became held up between the 400 metres and 300 metres when racing behind TICKLE LILY (J. Lyon), which commenced to give ground.

TICKLE LILY, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
