

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED
STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse
by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Friday, 25 April 2008

Stewards: J. Petzer (A/Chairman), M. Santoro (HT), N. Castle (M) & L Smith (Stewards),
D. Jonas (F) (Deputy Steward), Dr. P. Horridge (Veterinary Surgeon).

TRACK: Good 3

WEATHER: Overcast

Rail: True.

RACE 1 : BURNS CEILINGS MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes owing to the ambulance arriving late on course.

MAGIC MIDNIGHT (A. Herrmann) jumped away awkwardly.

BOW STREET RUNNER (W. Hughes) jumped away awkwardly and was then slow into stride.

LORD NATHAN (T. Zanker) jumped out at the start and brushed with GASEOSA (D. Dunn).

COOL SAAB (T. Baker) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto JEUNEALISTIC (D. Robinson).

MAGIC MIDNIGHT (A. Herrmann) made the turn near the 600 metres awkwardly.

Shortly after entering the straight LAND OF GOLD (J. Maund) was obliged to alter course to the outside of LORD NATHAN (T. Zanker) as that gelding commenced to weaken.

RACE 2 : GAWLER COLOUR WORLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 metres

SHIMLA (NZ), which was kicked by another runner on arrival at the barriers, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to race.

ANDY'S ANGEL (D. Carney) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto PORKY (J. Maund).

URAGANO (S. Price) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, inconveniencing SPARKLING APACHE (T. Zanker).

At the entrance to the straight KARVEMUP (M. Neilson) became momentarily held up behind SLIPSHOT (D. Tourneur) and was obliged to shift out to obtain clear running and then became held up for a number of strides behind BROADCASTER (A. Patterson).

Shortly after entering the straight SNAPERTUDE (K. Stra) became held up for a number of strides on the heels of PORKY (J. Maund).

Approaching the 50 metres SNAPERTUDE (K. Stra), which was improving, raced up onto the heels of URAGANO (S. Price), which was weakening, and altered course to the outside of that gelding and was then obliged to steady off the heels of PORKY (J. Maund), which was weakening, resulting in SNAPERTUDE shifting back in onto the heels of URAGANO, clipping that gelding's heels, becoming severely unbalanced and dislodging its rider K. Stra. As a consequence SLIPSHOT (D. Tourneur), which was following, was inconvenienced in avoiding the fallen rider. K. Stra was examined by the Club's Doctor and passed fit to fulfil her remaining engagements.

RACE 2 : GAWLER COLOUR WORLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 metres (Cont'd)

MALIBU DOLL was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported blood in the gelding's near side nostril. Mr. L. Macdonald, the Trainer of MALIBU DOLL, was advised the gelding would now be required to gallop 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future race in accordance with ARR.53A(7).

RACE 3 : SATAB "UP AND COMING CHALLENGE" CLASS 3 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

Racing to the 1200 metres SANDSATIONAL (M. Morita), which had commenced to improve into tight room, was obliged to check off the heels of DOUBLE RIPPLE (A. Herrmann) and LITTLE TOY (M. Neve) and as a result lost ground.

Inside the 150 metres AMEN'S SEA (L. Hopwood) shifted in towards the running line of FANTHEN (P. Roff). Thereafter, over the concluding 50 metres, FANTHEN rolled out under pressure and brushed with AMEN'S SEA prior to the winning post.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow L. Hopwood, the rider of the second placegetter AMEN'S SEA, to view the official footage in the straight. After doing so L. Hopwood lodged an objection against FANTHEN (P. Roff) being declared the winner on the grounds of alleged interference over the final 50 metres of the event. After considering the evidence, on viewing the official footage and acting on their own observations, Stewards *dismissed* L. Hopwood's objection.

Correct Weight for this event was further delayed to allow Stewards to review the start of this event in relation to SANDSATIONAL (M. Morita) and INVINCIBLE DANCER (S. Bailey) being slow to jump. Stewards were satisfied that neither horse was impeded by the barrier structure or any other external influence and Correct Weight was declared.

LITTLE TOY lost its near fore plate during the event.

RACE 4 : FLIGHT CENTRE GAWLER / KOKODA TRACK 0-81 HANDICAP - 1950 metres

FULL PLATE BARD lost its near fore plate during the event.

RACE 5 : PLENARY GROUP LONG TAN CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1050 metres

LOST DREAM, which was kicked on the off hind stifle on arrival at the barriers, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who declared the filly unfit. Acting on this report, Stewards withdrew LOST DREAM at 2.41 pm.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres REDSPLIT THUMB (J. Lyon) shifted in resulting in JATZ (D. Dunn) shifting in and away from that gelding onto IL LUPO (W. Hughes), making contact with that gelding, resulting in IL LUPO being tightened onto SPECULATE (M. Morita), brushing that gelding and tightening it onto PARTY CAT (A. Patterson). As a consequence JATZ, IL LUPO, SPECULATE and PARTY CAT were hampered and made contact for a number of strides. SPECULATE was then obliged to be steadied and lost its position. As a consequence LITTLEBOYBOO (J. Potter), which was following, was inconvenienced and had to check off the heels of PARTY CAT. J. Lyon was severely reprimanded and advised in future to take far greater care when commencing to shift ground. In coming to their decision not to lay a charge, Stewards took into account the racing manners of JATZ in the incident.

RACE 5 : PLENARY GROUP LONG TAN CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1050 metres (Cont'd)

Rounding the home turn LITTLEBOYBOO (J. Potter) commenced to roll out at the same time as SPECULATE (M. Morita), which was racing to its immediate outside, brushed with IL LUPO (W. Hughes), which maintained its line. As a result of the contact between SPECULATE and IL LUPO, IL LUPO laid back in onto SPECULATE, unbalancing both horses. At the same time LITTLEBOYBOO shifted out slightly tightening SPECULATE onto IL LUPO resulting in SPECULATE losing its position and becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of IL LUPO, clipping this gelding's heels, becoming unbalanced and dislodging its rider M. Morita. J. Potter was severely reprimanded for shifting ground and advised to take greater care in future. M. Morita was examined by the Club's Doctor and passed fit.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow J. Potter, the rider of the third placegetter LITTLEBOYBOO, to view the official footage shortly after the start.

JATZ was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the colt to be lame in the off hind leg. Mr. J. Cornell, representing Mr. D.A. Hayes, the Trainer of JATZ, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

RACE 6 : A J CRABB EVANSTON SPRINT - 1200 metres

ELECTION DRIVE (M. Neve) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto WHO'STHIS (B. Petherick), which lost its position.

YOUNG DOCTOR (T. Baker) and MOLOKAI'S LADD (J. Potter) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 1100 metres GLEESONS LANDING (A. Herrmann) was obliged to steady when racing in restricted room between JUST A GIGGLE (W. Hughes) to its inside and WILD HERO (J. Maund) to its outside.

Racing to the 400 metres GLEESONS LANDING (A. Herrmann) became held up on the heels of ELECTION DRIVE (M. Neve), which was weakening and was obliged to alter course to the outside of that gelding to obtain clear running.

Approaching the 50 metres GLEESONS LANDING (A. Herrmann) shifted out to improve resulting in WHO'STHIS (B. Petherick) having to be steadied and being hampered. A. Herrmann was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

WHO'STHIS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.

RACE 7 : DARREN MAGRO RACING STABLES GAWLER CUP - 1600 metres

SATARA (D. Dunn) shifted out on jumping away and brushed with DANDY JESTER (K. Stra).

MISS BALL (A. Herrmann) was slow to begin.

SAVLATE (NZ) (S. Price) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

MISS BALL (A. Herrmann) became held up for clear running behind SAVLATE (NZ) (S. Price) shortly after entering the straight and until inside the 150 metres.

Near the 50 metres VIZ VITAE (NZ) (B. Petherick), which had improved, shifted in to obtain clear ground and crossed the running line of MISS BALL (A. Herrmann), which had to be steadied. B. Petherick was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

RACE 8 : GAWLER STOCK FEEDS / GALLIPOLI / SABIS F&M CLASS 2 HANDICAP -
1200 metres

SHEEZA PERIL (L. Hopwood) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto SHE DEVIL (J. Lyon), brushing with that filly which was taken out onto SEA OF MILLAIS (D. Tourneur).

MISSUSMOY (C. Lindop) became held up for clear ground between the 400 and the 300 metres and thereafter, racing to the 150 metres, became awkwardly placed on the heels of PREAMIMMA (D. Dunn) and had to shift to the outside of that filly to obtain clear running.
