

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED
STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Murray Bridge Racecourse
by the Murray Bridge Racing Club on Monday, 9 June 2008

Stewards: G. Loch (Chairman), J. Petzer (HT), T. Williamson (M), N. Castle (F) & L. Smith (Stewards), M. White & J. Shea (Deputy Stewards), Dr. P. Horridge (Veterinary Surgeon)

TRACK: Slow 6

WEATHER: Overcast

Rail: Out 3 metres from 840 metres to 430 metres.

RACE 1 : TREVOR STEVENS HURDLE - 2812 metres

On jumping the hurdle near the 300 metres on the last occasion MATTY'S DREAM (P. Hamblin) and INDIAN LAKE (T. Allanson) brushed.

Inside the 100 metres RUDE 'N' ABRUPT (S. Pateman) rolled in onto NIP THE TIP (T. Wells), which was inclined to roll out.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to permit T. Wells, the rider of the second placegetter NIP THE TIP, and the gelding's Trainer Mr. J. Macmillan, to view the official footage over the concluding stages.

RACE 2 : JAKE SUTCLIFFE MAIDEN PLATE (Division 1) - 1206 metres

The start of this race was delayed owing to DYONYSIS proving difficult to load. Ms. R. Hodson, the Trainer of DYONYSIS, was advised a repetition of its behaviour may lead to action being taken against it.

Approaching the 800 metres SILVER CLIP (B. Hoppo) became awkward when racing between STUDENT PRINCE (G. Hoobin) and BOLD FURY (T. Zanker).

Inside the 200 metres GIFT OF KNOWLEDGE (T. Baker) rolled out and brushed LIGHTLY SPICED (C. Lindop).

BABYBRO, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

LIGHTLY SPICED, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities other than a lower than expected heart rate.

RACE 3 : SIMON JOHNSON MAIDEN PLATE (Division 2) - 1206 metres

AUSSIE STAAR (M. Vassallo) was slow to jump.

MAXIMUM CLASS (D. Robinson) jumped away very awkwardly and shifted out abruptly, contacting ORMAND LADY (K. Stra), which was hampered.

NEXT WAVE (J. Maund) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto SKILTON (S. Price), which was inconvenienced. Shortly afterwards NEXT WAVE shifted in onto AUSSIE STAAR (M. Vassallo), which was inconvenienced when tightened onto ORMAND LADY (K. Stra), which was hampered. NEXT WAVE continued to get its head up and race greenly thereafter.

RACE 3 : SIMON JOHNSON MAIDEN PLATE (Division 2) - 1206 metres (Cont'd)

Near the 500 metres ETESIAN (D. Dunn) became awkward and raced greenly for a short distance when racing inside AUSSIE STAAR (M. Vassallo).

RACE 4 : BEN HANSELMAN & TONY MAZZEO STEEPLECHASE - 3292 metres

At the steeple near the 300 metres on the first occasion BALMORAL BURN (T. Wells) took on the inside rail and crashed through, dislodging its rider. T. Wells was uninjured in the incident.

At the winning post on the first occasion BALMORAL BURN, which had continued on the inside of the course proper, jumped the inside rail and hampered LAUGHING IN DUBAI (A. Trinder).

At the steeple in the vicinity of the 1300 metres SET UP (B. Scott) jumped awkwardly and screwed on landing, unbalancing its rider.

At the steeple near the 1000 metres MADE OF MUSIC (S. Pateman) fell, dislodging its rider. S. Pateman was uninjured in the incident. MADE OF MUSIC was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a minor laceration to its near fore knee. First Aid was administered.

After jumping the steeple in the vicinity of the 900 metres MAYFAIR MAGIC (P. Hamblin) was eased out of the event. MAYFAIR MAGIC was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding had its strained near fore flexor tendon during the event. Mr. J. Searle, the Trainer of MAYFAIR MAGIC, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

Owing to the condition of the running rail and guard inside the steeple near the 300 metres, runners were directed around it on the second occasion.

BALMORAL BURN sustained minor lacerations to both hind legs during the event and was provided with First Aid. Mr. P. Jones, the Trainer of BALMORAL BURN, was advised that the gelding would now be required to complete the course to the satisfaction of Stewards in an Official Steeple Trial.

RACE 5 : CAMERON STORAGE & DISTRIBUTION / SABIS 2YO SPECIAL CONDITIONS HANDICAP - 1006 metres

The start of this event was delayed owing to ZIP LADY dislodging its rider T. Baker during the preliminary and proving difficult to capture. ZIP LADY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and ruled unfit to start. Acting on this advice ZIP LADY was withdrawn by Stewards at 1.40 pm.

BRIMARVI (S. Price) was slow to jump.

RACE 6 : SWIRE COLD STORAGE / SABIS F&M RATING 0-75 HANDICAP - 1406 metres

The start of this event was delayed owing to MARIA CELESTE proving difficult to load. Mr. P. Seater, representing Mr. T. Dabernig, the Trainer of the mare, was advised that a repetition of that mare's behaviour may lead to action being taken against it.

CALL TO MIND (M. Morita) was slow to jump.

RACE 6 : SWIRE COLD STORAGE / SABIS F&M RATING 0-75 HANDICAP - 1406 metres
(Cont'd)

FIERY LITTLE DEVIL (T. Baker) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto HABIT OF THE STARS (C. Lindop), which was inconvenienced when tightened onto KIARA NOVA (A. Herrmann).

Approaching the 300 metres LOLLY RAIN (A. Patterson), which had been inclined to lay in onto the heels of FIERY LITTLE DEVIL (T. Baker), shifted out onto DESERT PENNY (J. Potter) taking that mare out onto KIARA NOVA (A. Herrmann), which was obliged to steady and lose its position when tightened for room. A. Patterson was advised he was being given the benefit of a grave doubt as to the extent that his riding was responsible for the incident.

Near the 100 metres HABIT OF THE STARS (C. Lindop) was obliged to steady when tightened between MARIA CELESTE (S. Price), which shifted out, and LOLLY RAIN (A. Patterson), which had been taken in marginally by DESERT PENNY (J. Potter).

SHE'S HENNESSY and KIARA NOVA lost their off fore plates during the event.

KIARA NOVA suffered a puncture wound to the inside of its off fore cannon during the event and was provided with First Aid.

RACE 7 : REQUEST PERSONNEL HANDICAP - 1606 metres

TOAST TO LENNY (P. Crich) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto BERGSTROM (C. Lindop), which was inconvenienced.

Approaching the 200 metres ROCKFORD BAY (M. Morita), which was inclined to lay in, rolled in onto SAVLATE (NZ) (L. Hopwood), which was inconvenienced.

RACE 8 : DAVID EMMS RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1606 metres

On jumping away FLYING TRAPEZE (P. Gatt) was inconvenienced when tightened between CLASSIC DASH (L. Hopwood), which rolled out, and MOGGADEN (S. Bailey), which rolled in.

Near the 1000 metres WINGSPIEL (D. Tootell) was obliged to steady off the heels of MIGHTY KID (M. Hoppo), which lost ground momentarily.

Near the 100 metres MOGGADEN (S. Bailey) rolled in and brushed FLYING TRAPEZE (P. Gatt).

RACE 9 : GARY VAUGHAN / SABIS 3YO CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1006 metres

HAVANOTHERONE (S. Hillebrand) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto MILLION BUCKS (P. Gatt), which was inconvenienced.

ARTISTE CELEBRE (T. Zanker) was slow to jump.

Near the 900 metres SLEEQUE (S. Price) shifted out onto EAST TERRACE (A. Herrmann) taking that filly out onto BLUE PRUSSIAN (C. Lindop), which shifted out onto MILLION BUCKS (P. Gatt), which was inconvenienced.
