

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED
STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Allan Scott Park Morphettville Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 3 May 2008

Stewards: G. Loch (Chairman), J. Petzer (HT), M. Santoro (M), N. Castle (F) & L. Smith (Stewards), M. White, D. Jonas & Z. Hamilton (Deputy Stewards), Dr. P. Horridge & Dr. A. Cullimore (Veterinary Surgeons).

TRACK: Dead 4

WEATHER: Fine

Rail: Out 4 metres entire circuit.

RACE 1 : RENNIKS EVENTS HANDICAP - 1200 metres

HAPPY AS LARRY (D. Carney) and GOTHIC VAMPIRE (R. Plumb) jumped away awkwardly.

Shortly after the start GET STITCHED (K. Post) shifted in and contacted PRIVATE LIAISON (S. Price), which was inconvenienced.

Near the 700 metres POTOMAC (B. Petherick), which was inclined to race keenly, was forced to steady off the heels of FLY DE ANGELS (D. Tourneur).

Inside the 600 metres, in attempting to improve, POTOMAC (B. Petherick) rolled out onto GET STITCHED (K. Post) turning that gelding's hindquarters out.

Inside the 300 metres, in attempting to improve, PRIVATE LIAISON (S. Price) shifted out onto POTOMAC (B. Petherick), which was inconvenienced.

PRIVATE LIAISON was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : WILLIAMS REFRIGERATION & AIR CONDITIONING HANDICAP - 1000 metres

The start of this event was delayed owing to YOUR THOUGHTS rearing in its barrier after being loaded. YOUR THOUGHTS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg and unfit to start. Acting on that advice, Stewards withdrew YOUR THOUGHTS at 12.38 pm.

ON THE TRAIL (M. Hoppo) was slow to jump.

NOTALLOWED (D. Robinson) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, contacting BELLA SIMONETTA (W. Hughes). NOTALLOWED reacted and shifted in abruptly contacting the hindquarters of KAYEEMA JAY (J. Lyon), which were turned in.

MISS MONTECITO (D. Carney), which lost its hind legs on jumping away, was awkward for several strides and brushed with EIGHT UNDER (R. Plumb), which rolled out.

Inside the 300 metres BELLA SIMONETTA (W. Hughes) was obliged to steady when tightened for room by EIGHT UNDER (R. Plumb), which rolled in.

Inside the 200 metres LAGO BAY (A. Patterson) rolled out onto KINTYRE SPIRIT (D. Tourneur), which was inconvenienced.

ON THE TRAIL was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr. G. Lesnikowski, the Trainer of ON THE TRAIL, was advised that if the gelding were to prove similarly uncompetitive in future events, action may be taken against it.

RACE 2 : WILLIAMS REFRIGERATION & AIR CONDITIONING HANDICAP - 1000 metres
(Cont'd)

BELLA SIMONETTA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported filly to be lame in the near hind leg. Mr. J. Cornell, representing Trainer Mr. D.A. Hayes, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race. Mr. Cornell undertook to advise Stewards the results of a comprehensive veterinary examination at the Morphetville Equine Clinic.

RACE 3 : ALLAN SCOTT PARK MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1100 metres

On jumping away EL MAZE (C. Lever) shifted out and contacted PATAPAN (USA) (R. Plumb).

RESHUFFLES (A. Patterson) jumped away awkwardly.

Approaching the 200 metres CHEVAYA (T. Baker) and LORD BRAEMAR (S. Price) brushed on a number of occasions.

RESHUFFLES, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : FLIGHT CENTRE HANDICAP - 1200 metres

NOT AT ALALORDINARY (D. Carney) lost its hind legs on jumping away.

OUR DIOR (C. Lever) was inclined to race keenly in the early and middle stages of the race.

At the entrance to the straight, in attempting to improve, FELLINA (J. Lyon) shifted out onto THIS IS ME (P. Roff), which was forced to steady to avoid that mare's heels. J. Lyon was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

OUR DIOR, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : DISPLAYLINE HANDICAP - 2500 metres

EPONA MISS (J. Lyon) was slow to jump.

Passing the winning post on the first occasion until inside the 1400 metres, FRAACLASE (D. Tourneur) was obliged to race three wide without cover.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres FRAACLASE (D. Tourneur) was inclined to hang out and eventually became awkward between the heels of ALL ABOUT ANNIE (A. Patterson) and SPARKLING TOP (T. Baker), losing its position.

At the entrance to the straight THE OZIE BOY (K. Stra), which had been inclined to lay in, was obliged to steady off the heels of FOREIGN SCANDAL (D. Robinson) as that gelding shifted out in an attempt to improve. D. Robinson was severely reprimanded and to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

After entering the straight SILENT ACTION (R. Plumb) was unable to obtain clear ground when racing between the heels of ALL ABOUT ANNIE (A. Patterson) and RUDE 'N' ABRUPT (M. Hoppo).

RACE 5 : DISPLAYLINE HANDICAP - 2500 metres (Cont'd)

Near the 300 metres KURREWA (NZ) (M. Walters) shifted in onto AUTHENTIC STAR (S. Bailey), which was inconvenienced when taken in onto EPONA MISS (J. Lyon).

ALL ABOUT ANNIE, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

FOREIGN SCANDAL sustained a minor wound to the near hind cannon during the event.

RACE 6 : DISTINCTIVE HOMES HANDICAP - 1800 metres

TRULY BEAUTIFUL (D. Tourneur) jumped away awkwardly.

Inside the 300 metres TORA TORA TORA (K. Stra), in attempting to improve, shifted out onto BELLA'S BRO (C. Lever), which was inconvenienced.

Approaching the 200 metres GOOD BEHAVIOURBOND (R. Plumb), which was inclined to roll in onto SAVLATE (NZ) (S. Price), became awkward and was obliged to steady as that gelding rolled out.

RACE 7 : MYER HANDICAP - 1200 metres

On jumping away HIERONYMUS (NZ) (R. Plumb) shifted out and brushed VALOROSO (J. Lyon).

From the 700 metres COUNTESS OF TIBA (A. Patterson) was inclined to lay out.

At the entrance to the straight HIERONYMUS (NZ) (R. Plumb) rolled out and brushed UNDER THE RADAR (D. Tootell).

Near the 300 metres HIERONYMUS (NZ) (R. Plumb) and UNDER THE RADAR (D. Tootell) brushed.

Approaching the 200 metres UNDER THE RADAR (D. Tootell) shifted in onto HIERONYMUS (NZ) (R. Plumb) taking that gelding in onto SASSY SENORITA (S. Price), which was tightened onto FUN AT LAST (D. Carney), which was forced to check to avoid the heels of SOLOIST (D. Tourneur), which shifted out.

Inside the 200 metres GREEN MACHINE (NZ) (M. Morita) shifted in onto BOLD GIGGLE (B. Petherick) taking that gelding in onto COUNTESS OF TIBA (A. Patterson), which was obliged to steady. M. Morita was advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

M. Allen, the rider of SANJUAN, reported the gelding hung out throughout the event and after attempting to test his mount in the vicinity of the 300 metres, he had elected not to persist with his riding. SANJUAN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8 : MOUNT GAMBIER HOTEL HANDICAP - 1800 metres

SOVEREIGN CONQUEST (J. Maund) jumped away awkwardly.

BLACK EYED KNIGHT (NZ) (J. Lyon) was inclined to race keenly in the early and middle stages of the race.

RACE 8 : MOUNT GAMBIER HOTEL HANDICAP - 1800 metres (Cont'd)

Near the 700 metres, when being restrained off the heels of AMARIE (K. Stra), BLACK EYED KNIGHT (NZ) (J. Lyon) shifted out onto PUERTO BANUS (S. Price), which shifted away, resulting in SOVEREIGN CONQUEST (J. Maund) being inconvenienced.

PUERTO BANUS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.

GENERAL:**RACE 7 : MYER HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

Jockey M. Allen, the rider of SANJUAN, was charged with having breached ARR.87D in that he had in his possession a vest which, in the opinion of the Stewards, had been modified. He was found guilty and fined \$1000. In recognition of particular mitigating factors, Stewards determined to stay \$500 of the penalty on the proviso he did not breach the Rules regarding safety within the next twelve months.

JOCKEY SAMPLES:

Urine samples were taken from Jockeys K. Post and M. Morita.
