STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Allan Scott Park Morphettville Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Monday, 10 March 2008

RACE 1 : MYER HANDICAP - 1100 metres

Shortly after the start OUR DIOR (C. Lindop) rolled out onto PREDESTINED (P. Roff) taking that mare out onto AMBIKA (D. Dunn), which was inconvenienced.

From the 100 metres HURRICANE DANCER (C. Lever) was eased out of the event. C. Lever, the rider of HURRICANE DANCER, explained the mare had not raced with its customary zest and despite his efforts, was under pressure to hold its position from the 500 metres and he could offer no explanation for its performance. HURRICANE DANCER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare to be exhibiting mild symptoms of heat stress. First Aid was administered. Mr. P. Beshara, the Trainer of HURRICANE DANCER, advised the mare will now be spelled.

PREDESTINED was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : ALLAN SCOTT PARK MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1050 metres

Shortly after the start STARBIRD (C. Lindop) rolled in and contacted BRILLIANT LAD (C. Brown), which was inconvenienced.

RACE 3 : CHRYSLER JEEP DODGE HANDICAP - 1600 metres

On jumping away METRO GOLD (J. Lyon) shifted out and brushed THE OZIE BOY (J. Holder).

In the early stages THE OZIE BOY (J. Holder) was inclined to get its head up and be ungenerous.

From the 400 metres until in the vicinity of the 200 metres THE OZIE BOY (J. Holder) was unable to obtain clear ground when racing behind SON OF SPARTACUS (C. Brown) and inside KEEPERHAPPY (NZ) (D. Oliver).

After entering the straight IMPERIUM (J. Winks) became held up when racing behind RUDE 'N' ABRUPT (M. Hoppo) and inside METRO GOLD (J. Lyon) and then was unable to obtain clear ground in the straight and was not able to be tested until in the vicinity of the 100 metres.

From the 300 metres KEEPERHAPPY (NZ) (D. Oliver) was inclined to lay in under pressure. D. Oliver reported the gelding had been inclined to lay in and that it may exhibit soreness. KEEPERHAPPY (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : PEWSEY VALE STAKES - 1050 metres

MONTELMAR (C. Brown) jumped away awkwardly and brushed with MISS SORENSTAM (M. Neilson) as that filly rolled out, resulting in MONTELMAR over-reacting, shifting out and contacting INTELLIGENTSIA (J. Winks) as that filly rolled in, turning its hindquarters out.

KNIGHT VISION (S. Arnold) jumped away awkwardly.

Shortly after the start VIENNESE (D. Oliver) shifted out onto ELYSEES (C. Lever), which was inconvenienced.

In the early stages MISS SORENSTAM (M. Neilson) was inclined to over race. M. Neilson reported the filly, racing in blinkers for the first time, was less tractable than it had been previously.

Approaching the 300 metres MONTELMAR (C. Brown) became held up when racing behind VIENNESE (D. Oliver) and inside INTELLIGENTSIA (J. Winks), which was inclined to lay in under pressure.

D. Dunn, the rider of THE LOOK OF LOVE, explained the filly was inclined to lay out after he had commenced to turn and continued to lay out on straightening despite his attempts to correct it. THE LOOK OF LOVE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

MISS SORENSTAM sustained a small laceration to the near fore cannon during the event.

VIENNESE lost its off hind plate during the event.

RACE 5 : CMA RECYCLING STAKES - 1100 metres

HERE DE ANGELS lost its off hind plate during the event.

RACE 6 : SCHWEPPERVEESCENCE STAKES - 2000 metres

In the vicinity of the 400 metres EL DAANA (D. Dunn) became held up and had difficulty obtaining clear ground until inside the 300 metres.

After entering the straight CATALAN BAY (P. Mertens) became held up for a short distance when racing behind HEY ROSIE (C. Brown) and inside PRINCIPAL DAME (C. Lever).

Inside the 200 metres, in attempting to improve, EL DAANA (D. Dunn) rolled out onto IMPINGE (NZ) (L. Nolen), which was inconvenienced.

RACE 7 : SKYCITY ADELAIDE CUP - 3200 metres

On arrival on course ROAD TO ATHENS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported an abrasion to the near fore knee with localised swelling and passed the gelding fit to start.

The start of this race was delayed owing to GOTHIC MARIAN requiring farrier attention on arrival at the barriers.

Approaching the 600 metres SADDLER'S STORY (C. Newitt) clipped the heels of ROYAL PLAYER (D. Tourneur) as that gelding commenced to give ground.

RACE 7 : SKYCITY ADELAIDE CUP - 3200 metres (Cont'd)

Approaching the 500 metres GO MISSY (C. Symons), which had rolled out tightening DIRT MUSIC (P. Mertens) onto LACY UNDERALL (D. Dunn), in rolling back inwards to its original racing line, became hampered and was obliged to steady off the heels of RICHRACER (NZ) (D. Yendall), which shifted out. D. Yendall was severely reprimanded and advised in future to ensure he is sufficiently clear before shifting ground.

Near the 500 metres FOOLISH LAD (J. Potter) became held up and was obliged to steady off the heels of SHOW BARRY (E. Cassar) as that gelding commenced to give ground.

Approaching the 400 metres FOOLISH LAD (J. Potter) was obliged to steady when tightened between SHOW BARRY (E. Cassar), which rolled out as it continued to give ground, and SADDLER'S STORY (C. Newitt), which rolled in.

Approaching the 200 metres FOOLISH LAD (J. Potter) was obliged to steady off the heels of SADDLER'S STORY (C. Newitt) as that gelding rolled in.

Near the 100 metres, in attempting to improve outside EXALTED EGO (M. Neilson), which rolled out marginally, FOOLISH LAD (J. Potter) brushed TO A FAULT (NZ) (J. Holder).

RICHRACER (NZ) lost its off hind plate, GOTHIC MARIAN lost its off fore plate and LACEY UNDERALL lost its off hind plate during the event.

SADDLER'S STORY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be short in its action in front. Mr. R. Laing, the Trainer of SADDLERY'S STORY, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to accepting for a future trial or raced.

ROYAL PLAYER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

GOTHIC MARIAN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.

LACEY UNDERALL sustained lacerations to the off hind hock during the event. First Aid was administered.

LADY ATIRE (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare to be suffering heat stress. First Aid was administered.

RACE 8 : YALLAMBEE CLASSIC - 1200 metres

ROYAL ASSCHER (NZ) (D. Oliver), which was restless in the barriers, was slow to jump.

Inside the 200 metres M. Neilson, the rider of ALMOST CHEVAL, accidentally dropped his whip. M. Neilson was reprimanded and advised future instances of carelessness would lead to a penalty being imposed.

Approaching the 100 metres DIPLOMATIC FORCE (J. Benbow) and VIVACIOUS SPIRIT (C. Newitt) brushed.

SHREWD RHYTHM lost its near fore plate during the event.

RACE 9 : MARINA PIER HANDICAP - 1200 metres

AMICI FOREVER (K. Stra) was inclined to rear on jumping away.

On return to scale D. Yendall, the rider of GUNNER TOM, reported he was concerned with the gelding's action over the concluding stages. GUNNER TOM was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Ms. S. Murphy, the Trainer of GUNNER TOM, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to permit C. Lindop, the rider of the second placegetter ZAAZORRO, to view the official footage in the straight.
