

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED
STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Allan Scott Park Morphettville Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 17 May 2008

Stewards: G. Loch (Chairman), J. Petzer (HT), T. Williamson (M), N. Castle (F) & L. Smith (Stewards), D. Jonas, J. Shea & H. Milne (Deputy Stewards), Dr. P. Horridge & Dr. B. Agnew (Veterinary Surgeons).

TRACK: Dead 4

WEATHER: Overcast / Showery

Rail: Out 8 metres entire 1200 metres to Winning Post, 6 metres remainder.

RACE 1 : EVRIGHT.COM HANDICAP - 1050 metres

OUR CURRENCY (D. Tourneur) was slow to jump.

Approaching the finish BLAZING STARS (C. Lindop) rolled out onto BOLD LINE (J. Lyon), which was inconvenienced.

TAOS PLEASURE lost its off fore plate during the event.

RACE 2 : TORO HANDICAP - 1050 metres

The start of this event was delayed owing to PAPPA JACK proving difficult to load. Mr. J. Lockyer, the Trainer of PAPPA JACK, was advised that a repetition of the gelding's behaviour would lead to action being taken against it.

BRING THEM ON (J. Lyon) and ACHTACHAN (W. Hughes) were slow to jump.

SWOOP AND DESTROY (P. Gatt) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out abruptly.

HE'S A HOUNDOG (D. Tourneur) jumped away awkwardly.

Approaching the 800 metres PAPPA JACK (D. Carney) rolled in onto BACKSHEEH (D. Dunn), which was momentarily inconvenienced.

Inside the 300 metres BRING THEM ON (J. Lyon) became held up for a short distance when racing between the heels of MEADOWS DAN (A. Patterson) and HE'S A HOUNDOG (D. Tourneur).

Inside the 100 metres HE'S A HOUNDOG (D. Tourneur), which was inclined to lay in, rolled in and brushed BRING THEM ON (J. Lyon) as that filly had improved onto the heels of PAPPA JACK (D. Carney), and rolled out.

ZIP HOUND was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding had sustained a laceration to its near side cheek.

RACE 3 : PARTRICKS / DUNES HANDICAP - 1050 metres

MEAN JEAN (J. Lyon) and SAINTS BAY (A. Patterson) jumped away awkwardly.

After entering the straight MEAN JEAN (J. Lyon) raced greenly and was inclined to shift about under pressure.

RACE 4 : ALLAN SOCTT PARK MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1200 metres

Approaching the 800 metres EL MAZE (C. Lindop) shifted in marginally onto DISQUIET (R. Plumb) taking that filly in onto LORD BRAEMAR (C. Lever), which was obliged to steady when tightened for room. C. Lindop was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

FUN AT LAST lost its near fore plate during the event.

LORD BRAEMAR was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : CRANIOFACIAL AUSTRALIA HANDICAP - 1522 metres

HAWKSTER (J. Lyon) jumped away very awkwardly and shifted out abruptly, almost dislodging its rider.

After entering the straight BLOW ME AWAY (M. Neilson) was inclined to lay in under pressure. BLOW ME AWAY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

Over the concluding stages VINEGAR HILL (C. Lindop) rolled out marginally onto BARTER TIME (M. Hoppo), which was inclined to lay in under pressure.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to permit M. Hoppo, the rider of the second placegetter BARTER TIME, and that gelding's trainer, Mr. P. Macdonald, to view the official footage over the final 100 metres.

BELTIJA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6 : DU PLESSIS AUCTION GALLERY HANDICAP - 2032 metres

TORA TORA TORA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival on course who reported the gelding to be suffering symptoms of colic. Acting on that advice, Stewards withdrew TORA TORA TORA at 11.58 am.

The start of this event was delayed owing to MAGIC MINSTREL becoming cast in the barriers after being loaded. MAGIC MINSTREL was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who declared the gelding unfit to start. Acting on that advice, Stewards withdrew MAGIC MINSTREL at 2.56 pm. Ms. L. Conlon, representing Ms. J. Joiner, the Trainer of MAGIC MINSTREL, was advised a repetition of the gelding's behaviour may lead to action being taken against it. COMPLETE PACKAGE, which was in the adjoining barrier stall, was also examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who declared the filly fit to start.

CIVIL (P. Crich) and ALSO (D. Tootell) were slow to jump.

COMPLETE PACKAGE (S. Bailey) and SAVLATE (NZ) (M. Morita) jumped away very awkwardly.

BOSS IRON (A. Patterson) raced fiercely in the early and middle stages.

Approaching the finish TWIN TOWN (GB) (C. Lindop) rolled out onto GOOD BEHAVIOURBOND (D. Dunn), which was marginally inconvenienced.

RACE 6 : DU PLESSIS AUCTION GALLERY HANDICAP - 2032 metres (Cont'd)

BRIEF FINALE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

COMPLETE PACKAGE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the filly to be mildly "tying up". First Aid was administered.

RACE 7 : CLEANEVENT HANDICAP - 1600 metres

At the entrance to the straight PRINCE EYENO (M. Neilson) shifted out onto MRS SPUDLEY (T. Baker) tightening that mare onto BELLA GRANDE (J. Lyon), which was taken out onto the hindquarters of SHESALWAYSAWOMAN (NZ) (D. Dunn), which were turned out.

Near the 500 metres MRS SPUDLEY (T. Baker) shifted out onto BELLA GRANDE (J. Lyon), which was obliged to race in restricted room inside SHESALWAYSAWOMAN (NZ) (D. Dunn) for some distance, eventually losing its position.

Approaching the 200 metres PRINCE EYENO (M. Neilson) rolled out onto MRS SPUDLEY (T. Baker), which was inconvenienced.

MR CHAT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8 : PEWSEY VALE HANDICAP - 1050 metres

On jumping away SHANGHAI LIL (M. Hoppo) shifted out and contacted GUNCHASE (D. Tootell), which was inconvenienced.

GO GIGGLE (K. Stra) knuckled severely on jumping away.

TIS ISAT (M. Neilson) jumped away awkwardly and shortly afterwards was inconvenienced by GRANDPRIX KOTENCO (D. Tourneur), which shifted in.

Near the 200 metres BOLD GIGGLE (S. Bailey) became held up when racing between the heels of GLEESONS LANDING (A. Herrmann) and GRANDPRIX KOTENCO (D. Tourneur).

GENERAL:

Jockey G. Hoobin, who was replaced in Races 2 and 3, was interviewed by telephone with regard to the circumstances of his being replaced. He explained he had been thrown from a horse at the stables during the morning and injured his shoulder. As the injury had deteriorated, he intended seeking medical attention. Stewards instructed G. Hoobin to provide a Doctor's report with regard to the injury and in addition to have the Doctor verify his weight. He was further instructed if he was unsuccessful in obtaining a Doctor's appointment this afternoon, he would be required to attend Allan Scott Park Morphettville races and weigh in front of the Stewards. G. Hoobin was further questioned regarding his failure to respond to a direction of the Stewards in that any rider unable to fulfil his riding engagements must inform the Stewards as early as possible. Stewards will conduct an inquiry into the circumstances of his replacement and his failure to respond to the Stewards' direction at a date to be fixed.
