**STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT**

**Report on Race Meeting held at Allan Scott Park Morphettville Racecourse**  
**by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 24 May 2008**

**TRACK:** Good 3

**WEATHER:** Fine

**Rail:** Out 8 metres to Winning Post, 6 metres remainder.

**RACE 1 : TOOHEYS NEW HANDICAP - 1100 metres**

Mr. W. Smart, the Trainer of SILENT SOPHIA, was questioned regarding the presentation of the mare without the correct approved gear, being concussion plates. After considering the explanation provided, Mr. Smart was fined \$100 for having breached ARR.140A. SILENT SOPHIA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival on course and passed fit to start.

FELLINA shifted its near fore plate during the event. FELLINA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the toe clip had penetrated the sole of the hoof and First Aid was applied.

AMBIKA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a trace of blood in the mare's near side nostril. Mr. B. Brook, the Trainer of AMBIKA, was advised the mare would be required to gallop 1000 metres satisfactorily in the presence of a Steward in accordance with ARR.53A(7).

**RACE 2 : ALLAN SCOTT PARK MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1800 metres**

Near the 500 metres TRADESMAN'S CHOICE (A. Herrmann) was obliged to ease away from the heels of BRILLIANT LIES (M. Neilson), which had commenced to lose its position.

R. Plumb, the rider of WOODLAND JACK which settled further back in today's event than it did at its most recent start at Allan Scott Park Morphettville on 10 May 2008, explained on that occasion he had been instructed to attempt to ride the gelding more forward owing to an apparent lack of pace in the event whereas in today's race, in which adequate pace was expected, he had been instructed to allow WOODLAND JACK to settle back. Mr. P. Shepherdson, representing Mr. R. Jolly the Trainer of WOODLAND JACK, confirmed the instructions to R. Plumb and that the instructions given at the previous start were solely related to the absence of a leader. R. Plumb and Mr. Shepherdson were advised their explanations would be reported.

**RACE 3 : DULUX AUSTRALIA HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

STANLEY BRIDGE (D. Carney), LINDERA (K. Stra) and HIGH'N'RYE (J. Lyon) were slow to begin.

EXALTED KEETAH (A. Patterson) knuckled on jumping away.

Throughout the event DON'T DOUBT ME (D. Dunn) was inclined to race greenly and shift about.

**RACE 3 : DULUX AUSTRALIA HANDICAP - 1200 metres (Cont'd)**

Approaching the 400 metres ROCKIN RAPTURE (D. Tourneur), in an attempt to improve, shifted out onto NEW FANTASY (C. Lindop) taking that colt out onto HIGH'N'RYE (J. Lyon), which was taken out onto EAU DE JOIE (P. Gatt), resulting in both runners being taken wide. D. Tourneur was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

DON'T DOUBT ME (D. Dunn) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

Approaching the finish ZARBIKA (T. Baker) became held up when racing in restricted room between BLEWMAN FANTASTIC (R. Plumb) and ROCKIN RAPTURE (D. Tourneur).

C. Lever, the rider of IMPERSONATOR, reported that colt was inclined to lay out from the 700 metres.

BLEWMAN FANTASTIC was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported slight shin soreness to the off foreleg.

**RACE 4 : CHRYSLER JEEP DODGE HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

HAPPY BANKER (S. Price) raced four wide without cover throughout the event.

At the entrance to the straight SARATOGA DREAMS (D. Dunn) was held up briefly when racing between the heels of CHEVAYA (R. Plumb) and VERCOR ROAD (M. Neilson).

S. Price, the rider of HAPPY BANKER which performed below expectations, explained he had been instructed to attempt to ride the gelding slightly more forward than at its recent starts, however, he felt it had not exhibited sufficient speed to fulfil those instructions and due to the position of runners to his inside, he felt he had no option other than for HAPPY BANKER to race in the position it had. S. Price stated that from the 500 metres HAPPY BANKER had been inclined to lay out and under riding at the entrance to the straight, had not improved in its usual manner. He added that post-race HAPPY BANKER's breathing appeared to be unusually heavy, given it was well into its preparation. HAPPY BANKER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

CHEVAYA lost its near fore plate during the event.

**RACE 5 : CON YAMAS MEMORIAL HANDICAP - 2500 metres**

Passing the winning post on the first occasion ALSO (D. Tootell) was inclined to lay out for a short distance.

ROYAL BLEVIC (D. Tourneur) was inclined to race three wide without cover until the vicinity of the 1400 metres.

Near the 1200 metres, as the pace eased, GOOD BEHAVIOURBOND (D. Dunn) eased out and away from the heels of TOMS RAGE (C. Lindop) resulting in SALLUM (K. Stra) shifting out onto VIZ VITAE (NZ) (R. Plumb), which was taken out onto ROBEECA (A. Patterson) forcing both horses to race wide on that turn.

At the entrance to the straight NIP THE TIP (P. Roff) became held up for a short distance when racing inside the heels of RUNAWAY WALK (T. Baker).

**RACE 5 : CON YAMAS MEMORIAL HANDICAP - 2500 metres (Cont'd)**

After entering the straight BENEFIT ROAD (J. Potter) had difficulty obtaining clear ground and near the 200 metres was inconvenienced when tightened between RUNAWAY WALK (T. Baker), which shifted out, and VIZ VITAE (NZ) (R. Plumb), which rolled in when being inclined to shift away from SALLUM (K. Stra), which laid in.

Approaching the 200 metres NIP THE TIP (P. Roff) became held up when racing behind FOREIGN SCANDAL (D. Robinson), which had commenced to give ground.

KURREWA (NZ), which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame behind. Mr. D. Kolpin, the Trainer of KURREWA (NZ), was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

SALLUM suffered a small laceration to the off fore knee during the event. First Aid was administered.

**RACE 6 : EXCEL RENT A CAR HANDICAP - 1522 metres**

Near the 800 metres BLACKFORD (C. Lindop), which had commenced to race keenly, shifted away from the heels of SPIRIT OF CAPRI (D. Tourneur) and contacted ZENAL (M. Walters), which was hampered and then obliged to race without cover.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres, when racing in neat room inside HIERONYMNUS (NZ) (D. Tootell), RUBIGAME (J. Potter) became unbalanced for several strides.

**RACE 7 : NEIL SACHSE FOUNDATION MAY 31 HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

SELLERS (M. Neilson) was slow to jump.

BOLD GIGGLE (R. Plumb) jumped away awkwardly.

Shortly after the start SELLERS (M. Neilson) was inconvenienced when tightened between MADE YOUR MARK (P. Gatt), which shifted out, and LIKABLE WILL (M. Walters), which rolled in.

Approaching the 1000 metres MY STAR DANE (J. Maund) rolled in and contacted SCARY SMOKOVEC (M. Morita), which was inconvenienced.

Near the 1000 metres LIKABLE WILL (M. Walters) shifted in onto NOT AT ALLORDINARY (D. Robinson) forcing that mare in onto TWO FUHR ONE (D. Dunn), which was inconvenienced. M. Walters was reprimanded and reminded of her obligations when shifting ground in future.

Near the 800 metres SELLERS (M. Neilson), which had commenced to race keenly and improve inside the heels of EDGE OFF (B. Claridge) as that gelding rolled in, shifted in onto NOT AT ALLORDINARY (D. Robinson) taking that mare in onto TWO FUHR ONE (D. Dunn), which rolled in and brushed AL MAHARA (S. Price), which was inconvenienced momentarily when tightened for room.

After entering the straight NOT AT ALLORDINARY (D. Robinson) was unable to obtain clear ground for a short distance.

From the 300 metres MADE YOUR MARK (P. Gatt) had difficulty obtaining clear ground.

**RACE 7 : NEIL SACHSE FOUNDATION MAY 31 HANDICAP - 1200 metres (Cont'd)**

Inside the 100 metres SCARY SMOKOVEC (M. Morita) was obliged to steady when tightened between MCARCH (S. Bailey), which was inclined to shift away from BRAVEWOOD (S. Price) as that gelding improved to its inside, and BOLD GIGGLE (R. Plumb), which held its line.

**RACE 8 : SCHWEPPES HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

GIGGLE ROCKET (S. Bailey) jumped away awkwardly.

GOONDI (D. Dunn) jumped away awkwardly and shortly after was inconvenienced by TWIN TRIST (C. Lindop), which shifted out abruptly.

Near the 1000 metres VISION OF FLIGHT (J. Lyon), which was inclined to race keenly, shifted in and brushed SHEEZA PERIL (A. Herrmann).

VISION OF FLIGHT (J. Lyon) continued to race keenly in the middle stages of the event.

Inside the 200 metres VISION OF FLIGHT (J. Lyon) shifted out onto PRIVATE LIAISON (S. Price), which was inconvenienced.
