STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Penola Racecourse
by the Penola Racing Club on Sunday, 23 March 2008

RACE 1 : KEN POLLARD MEMORIAL / SABIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately three minutes owing to TAWRRIFIC FORCE (J. Maund) being loaded into the incorrect barrier stall and having to be reloaded.

SIMPLY SCARLET (P. Marks) and EWOOD PARK (M. Walters) were slow to begin.

EWOOD PARK (M. Walters) raced greenly in the early stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 800 metres SIMPLY SCARLET (P. Marks) rolled out onto the heels of ARCTIC TERN (C. Lever) and had to be eased, resulting in LADY AVACAN (K. Stra) having to take hold off the heels of SIMPLY SCARLET.

Shortly after entering the straight UPMARKET ANGLAISE (T. Zanker) was unable to obtain clear ground when racing between the heels of TAWRRIFIC FORCE (J. Maund) and LUSKIN TOUCH (D. Robinson).

In the vicinity of the 200 metres LUSKIN TOUCH (D. Robinson), which was inclined to race greenly in the straight, rolled in slightly at the same time as UPMARKET ANGLAISE (T. Zanker) rolled out marginally, resulting in UPMARKET ANGLAISE clipping the heels of LUSKIN TOUCH, dipping and unbalancing its rider, who was dislodged. T. Zanker was uninjured in the incident.

In the vicinity of the 100 metres LADY AVACAN (K. Stra) was reluctant to take a tight run to the inside of EMKAMENA (G. Hoobin).

RACE 2 : DOWFARM MACHINERY / SABIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 metres

BOLTCUTTER (P. Marks) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

J. Dertilis, the rider of KINA, reported he had asked the mare for an effort approaching the 600 metres and it failed to respond to his riding. He added he became concerned with the mare's action in the vicinity of the 300 metres and for that reason eased KINA out of the event. KINA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : WATTLE RANGE COUNCIL RATING 0-72 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

FLAMING SAMBUCA (A. Herrmann) was inclined to lay out from the 600 metres to the finish of the race.

RACE 4 : ELIFT / MEDIA CHALLENGE 2008 (HEAT 8) - 1300 metres

SOLITAS (P. Marks) was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 300 metres GOLDEN SNIP (J. Maund) rolled out and brushed HEZABOUT (D. Tootell).

In the vicinity of the 200 metres IRKUTSK (M. Walters) had to check when disappointed for a run between GOLDEN SNIP (J. Maund), which shifted out slightly, and HEZABOUT (D. Tootell), which shifted in under riding. D. Tootell was severely reprimanded and advised in future he would be required to stop riding and straighten his mount sooner than he had on this occasion.

RACE 5 : HEYWARDS ROYAL OAK HOTEL RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

PRE DETERMINED (NZ) (M. Walters) was slow to begin.

HICONI (C. Lever) jumped away extremely awkwardly and shifted out making heavy contact with ADILHTAM (NZ) (P. Marks), which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

From the vicinity of the 400 metres WISTIK (J. Dertilis) was unable to obtain clear ground until the entrance to the straight.

RACE 6 : BARRY MANEY FORD RATING 0-65 HANDICAP - 1300 metres

KANEJAKE, which was fractious in the float en route to the course, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival and passed fit to start.

VAIN MAR, which became fractious in the wash bay prior to the race, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported blood from one nostril as a result of knocking its head and ruled the mare unfit to start. Acting on this advice, Stewards withdrew VAIN MAR at 3.24 pm.

RAH RAH (P. Crich) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto HABIT OF THE STARS (P. Marks), which lost its position when tightened onto KANEJAKE (A. Herrmann).

MULOORINA (J. Lyon) rounded the turn in the vicinity of the 1000 metres awkwardly.

MISS MONEY TREE (M. Walters) was held up from the 400 metres until the vicinity of the 300 metres when racing behind FINAL DRAFT (K. Stra) and inside LACONIA (M. Munday).

In the vicinity of the 300 metres LACONIA (M. Munday) commenced to lay out under pressure making contact with CHEEKY MAN (K. Post) on a number of occasions in the straight. M. Munday was advised in future he would be required to stop riding and straighten his mounts when they commence to shift ground.

MARANA MAJIC (S. Hillebrand) was unable to obtain clear ground from in the vicinity of the 200 metres until the 50 metres.

MISS MONEY TREE (M. Walters) raced in restricted room over the concluding 50 metres when inside of KANEJAKE (A. Herrmann).

J. Lyon, the rider of MULOORINA, advised Stewards that after rounding the turn in the vicinity of the 1000 metres he had become concerned with MULOORINA's action, however, the gelding picked up the bit and continued to race until the home turn. After rounding the home turn he again became concerned with its action and for this reason did not ride the gelding out in his usual manner. MULOORINA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Mr. D. O'Leary, the Trainer of MULOORINA, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

RACE 7 : KATNOOK ESTATE PENOLA CUP - 1700 metres

LLAYNE BE (K. Stra) was slow to begin.

On jumping away BRAD STAR (P. Marks) and MEZAIRE (NZ) (M. Walters) came together and brushed.

RACE 8 : KPA INDUSRIAL / PENOLA RECYCLING DEPOT MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 metres

LORD TAOS (J. Maund) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, making contact with KINGSTON CON (P. Marks).

YESQUIRE (C. Lever) slipped behind on jumping away and shortly after was inconvenienced by SURREAL GOLD (K. Post), which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

SURREAL GOLD (K. Post) was inclined to race greenly and roll about in the early stages of the event and near the 1000 metres brushed with KINGSTON CON (P. Marks) on two occasions.

TIKONA (M. Walters) commenced to lay in rounding the home turn and approaching the 200 metres shifted in under riding onto PRINCESS PIRATE (J. Lyon), which was forced to alter course to the outside of that gelding. M. Walters was advised of her obligations when her mounts commence to shift ground.

In the vicinity of the 100 metres BALANCE THE BOOKS (A. Herrmann) was unable to obtain clear ground when racing tight to the inside of KINGSTON CON (P. Marks), which was inclined to lay in under pressure.

- Race 6 HABIT OF THE STARS and LOTZA ACTION.
- Race 7 KINGSTON DIRECTION and SARATOGA DEMON.
