Report on Race Meeting held at Strathalbyn Racecourse

RACE 1 : SACA PAST PLAYERS ASSOCIATION / SABIS 2YO CLASS 1 HANDICAP -
1350 metres

MAJESTIC JEWEL (P. Gatt) shifted out and away from LIGHTNING LLOYD (C. Lindop) and inconvenienced CAMPDOWN (A. Herrmann).

ROCKIN RAPTURE (L. Stojakovic) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 800 metres ROCKIN RAPTURE (L. Stojakovic) shifted in and inconvenienced LIGHTNING LLOYD (C. Lindop).

Approaching the 700 metres GOLDSTINGER (M. Neilson) shifted out slightly to improve and in doing so inconvenienced BLEWMAN FANTASTIC (D. Dunn) and CAMPDOWN (A. Herrmann), which were taken wider on the track.

ROCKIN RAPTURE (L. Stojakovic) raced greenly in the straight.

LIGHTNING LLOYD, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : DAISH IRRIGATION / SABIS 3YO MAIDEN PLATE (Division 1) - 1200 metres

On jumping away HUMAWAY (T. Baker) and CHERYLEE (M. Neilson) came together and brushed.

GIGGLE ROCKET (B. Petherick) and LE FEVRE TERRACE (M. Hoppo) jumped away awkwardly.

CENTRED (L. Hopwood) laid in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 150 metres, shifted in and bumped LE FEVRE TERRACE (M. Hoppo). L. Hopwood was reminded of her obligations and advised in future she would be expected to stop riding and straighten soon than she did on this occasion.

Inside the 200 metres ABU DHABI DANCER (S. Price) laid in under pressure tightening GIGGLE ROCKET (B. Petherick) for a short distance.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres D. Tourneur, the rider of THE BIG BAY BAND, eased the gelding from the even as he became concerned with its action. THE BIG BAY BAND was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a higher than expected heart rate but no other visible abnormalities.

CATS GALORE (P. Gatt) rounded the turn in the vicinity of the 800 metres awkwardly and lost ground.

RACE 2 : DAISH IRRIGATION / SABIS 3YO MAIDEN PLATE (Division 1) - 1200 metres

S. Price, the rider of ABU DHABI DANCER, explained he had settled behind the speed as instructed and travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event, however, shortly after entering the straight the gelding was inclined to shift about and he became concerned with its action and for this reason had not ridden ABU DHABI DANCER out in his normal manner over the concluding 150 metres. ABU DHABI DANCER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : STEPHEN BARRATT / SABIS 3YO MAIDEN PLATE (Division 2) – 1200 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately five minutes owing to FRENZIED GIGGLE (S. Bailey) taking charge of its rider en route to the barriers when the saddle on that gelding shifted. S. Bailey dismounted from the gelding and required medical attention. S. Bailey was transported to hospital for observation.

On jumping away E'MINOR (D. Dunn) shifted in and made contact with SUGIHARA (A. Herrmann).

On jumping away SOME SORTA RANI (A. Patterson) and ORIENTAL SLING (M. Hoppo) came together and brushed.

B. Hoppo, the rider of BOLD BRIACO, became concerned with the gelding's action shortly after entering the straight and for this reason did not ride the gelding out in his normal manner. BOLD BRIACO was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported excess upper respiratory noise. Mr. A. Peressin, the Trainer of the gelding, was advised the results of an endoscopic examination are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

RACE 4 : BARRY JARMAN MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 metres

AQUAPLANE (J. Lyon) shifted out on jumping away and brushed URAGANO (S. Price).

LOTTYLIEL (P. Roff) was slow to begin.

PACKER (T. Baker) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

URAGANO (S. Price) rounded the turn in the vicinity of the 1300 metres awkwardly and got its head up whilst being restrained.

THIRD TAKE (C. Lindop) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight forcing that rider to stop riding and straighten in the vicinity of the 100 metres.

RACE 5 : PEATS SOIL & GARDEN SUPPLIES RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

On arrival at the barriers TAHASSOLLY was kicked by another runner. TAHASSOLLY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to start.

WARWICK'S BROTHER (T. Zanker) and TAHASSOLLY (P. Gatt) came together and brushed on jumping away.

FREUD (D. Robinson) was slow to begin.

BONEGILLA (J. Potter) raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

RACE 6 : ALEXANDRINA COUNCIL CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

EAST TERRACE (M. Hoppo) shifted out on jumping away tightening LAKE C'EYRE (D. Tourneur) onto DANGEROUS SONG (A. Herrmann).

RED SAAB (D. Dunn) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

EATERN ROCKER (B. Petherick) was slow into stride.

At the entrance to the straight JUGSTAR (S. Price) became held up for a short distance on the heels of RIDGE OF GOLD (J. Potter) when taken out by LAKE C'EYRE (D. Tourneur), which shifted out slightly. Thereafter JUGSTAR had difficulty obtaining clear ground until inside the 100 metres.

Approaching the 100 metres M. Neilson, the rider of FOOTLIGHT, accidentally dropped his whip when it was struck from his hand by the whip of M. Neve, the rider of MAKES NO SENSE.

Approaching the finish PORKY (L. Hopwood) had to stop riding when forced to race in restricted room between RED SAAB (D. Dunn), which rolled out and BELLBOOKANDCANDLE (J. Maund), which shifted in slightly.

RACE 7 : PEATS NITRA MULCH RATING 0-81 HANDICAP - 1350 metres

LOTTO BLUES (L. Hopwood) jumped away awkwardly.

BEAUJOLANG (M. Hoppo) was slow to begin.

From the vicinity of the 800 metres until near the 500 metres BEAUJOLANG (M. Hoppo) commenced to race fiercely and in being restrained rolled out on a number of occasions, brushing TEE RUBBLE (C. Lindop).

C. Lever, the rider of SURPRISE END (GB), reported to Stewards that he had become concerned with the gelding's action at the entrance to the straight and for that reason had not ridden SURPRISE END (GB) out in his usual manner. SURPRISE END (GB) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities other than a lower than expected heart rate.

RACE 8 : PEATS CULTURED COMPOST RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 2050 metres

MISSUSMOY (C. Lindop) jumped away awkwardly.

On jumping away RAISINFUNS (A. Herrmann) shifted out and away from AURION (M. Neilson) and brushed WATERHOLE (D. Tourneur).

TOMS RAGE (D. Robinson) raced greenly in the early stages of the event.

CLASSIC DASH (C. Lever) became held up in the vicinity of the 600 metres until inside the 500 metres when racing behind MR CONTROLLER (L. Hopwood), which commenced to weaken.

P. Gatt, the rider of FLYING TRAPEZE, reported the gelding hung in severely throughout the event. FLYING TRAPEZE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8 : PEATS CULTURED COMPOST RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 2050 metres
(Cont'd)

MISSUSMOY, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

DADDY MAC, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be suffering atrial fibrillation. Mr. D. Bonetti, the Trainer of DADDY MAC, was advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

RACE 9 : WEST END BREWERY TOOHEYS NEW MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres

Acting on confirmed advice from Trainer Mr. J.B. O'Connor, the Trainer of BIANCO NERO, that the gelding had a haematoma on its near side and was unfit to race, Stewards withdrew BAINCO NERO at 9.00 am.

DESIRING (NZ) (P. Gatt) and BOLD FURY (T. Zanker) jumped away awkwardly.

In the vicinity of the 1200 metres MORTLOCK (A. Herrmann) shifted out abruptly inconveniencing BIRICHINA (NZ) (W. Hughes), which was taken out onto BETTER BOND (T. Baker), taking this gelding out onto SWIPER (NZ) (M. Neve), which had to be eased.

From the vicinity of the 600 metres until near the 500 metres CALL CENTRE (D. Tourneur) was unable to obtain clear ground when racing behind BIRICHINA (NZ) (W. Hughes), which had commenced to weaken.

SWIPER (NZ) (M. Neve) laid in under pressure in the straight.

Approaching the 100 metres M. Neve, the rider of SWIPER (NZ), accidentally dropped her whip. M. Neve was fined \$50 under ARR.137(a) for carelessness. After taking into account M. Neve's recent record in relation to dropping her whip, she was advised that any future carelessness may result in an increased penalty.
