**RACE 1 – WEST COAST WELDING / WEST COAST FUNERALS / ELLIOTT'S BAKERY/
BECK BROTHERS CELLARS / JL & MW HEIN / LANDMARK SABIS MAIDEN
PLATE – 1000 metres**

TUNGSTEN STEEL (M. Allen) was slow into stride.

**RACE 2 – ELDERS ROBCO / FOX FREIGHTLINES / STREAKY BAY CABINET
MAKERS / ABB / CEDUNA BULK HAULIERS / FREE WEST QUARRY
PRODUCTS RATING 0-68 HCP – 1000 metres**

In the vicinity of the 200 metres RIPPLESON (S. Rowley) shifted in under riding forcing S. Rowley to stop riding momentarily and straighten her mount.

Correct Weight was delayed to allow S. Hillebrand, rider of BEAU'S GIFT, to put a submission to the Stewards that that gelding be declared a non-runner as, in his opinion, it was being held when the start was effected. After taking evidence from starter G. Woods and the barrier attendant attending to the horse, and acting on their own observations, Stewards declared the horse to be a starter.

**RACE 3 – LINCOLN ESTATE / LETCHER & MORONEY RATING 0-68 HCP –
1400 metres**

Stewards declared PUBLIC ENEMY and SUNNY OASIS as late scratchings at 12:40pm due to no riders being available.

DEVICES (M. Allen) was slow to begin.

When questioned S. Hillebrand, the rider of ANNIE JANE, explained that whilst under pressure rounding the home turn ANNIE JANE rolled in and brushed the running rail. He added that the mare failed to improve in the straight.

ANNIE JANE, which performed poorly, was examined by the Clubs Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 – STREAKY BAY HOTEL MOTEL CLASS B HCP - 1200 metres

RACE 5 – CARLTON DRAUGHT / STREAKY BAY COMMUNITY HOTEL CUP
(Heat 6 BILL HOLLAND SERIES) - 1800 metres

MIGHTY BEAN (S. Bailey), was slow to begin.

Passing the post on the first occasion EAGLE JUAN (L. Hopwood), which was racing keenly, was obliged to steady of the heels of RODETO (B. Hoppo), which shifted in. B. Hoppo was reprimanded and advised in future to shift ground only when he was entitled to do so.

In the vicinity on the 1400 metres MIGHTY BEAN (S. Bailey), which was racing keenly, improved onto the heels of EAGLE JUAN (L. Hopwood) and had to be restrained.
